Alumni Get-together August 2018



Alumni get together of silver jubilee batch of 1993 along with their seniors was organized at R.I.T., Rajaramnagar on 11th August 2018. All the alumni gathered in the video conference hall. Hon. R.D. Sawant, Secretary Kasegaon Education Society and Hon. Shamrao Anna, Chairman, Rajrambapu Sahakari Bank Ltd. Peth graced this gathering. Get-together started with the welcome of all alumni and faculty members. To take the alumni members down the memory lane, a video clip ('Glorious Moments in RIT') made by alumni cell having a collection of the photos of the alumni right from 1987 batch was shown. All the alumni enjoyed this video clip. Then the guests were then welcomed by presenting them a sapling by the hands of Mr. Nazir Shaikh, Chairman, RIT Alumni Association. The guests inaugurated the function by 'watering the plant'.

Inauguration was followed by address of Mr. Nazir Shaikh. He highlighted the growth of RIT Alumni Association and how it has played a vital role in the development of the institute. He also discussed how the alumni of RIT have been successfully placed at important and high positions in the society. He appealed the alumni present for the get-together to voluntarily contribute for the further development of the institute. He also discussed about setting up of foundry for students as a startup by Alumni in RIT campus.

Dr. Sushma Kulkarni, Director, RIT, then addressed the gathering. She highlighted the development of the institute since its inception in 1983. She also added the recent achievements of RIT in different rankings by various agencies and magazines. She then discussed about the new curriculum which has been implemented in RIT from the current academic year.

Choice Based Curriculum System (CBCS) as it is called as a new initiative by RIT wherein a student can choose courses of his/her choice right from the first year of his/her studies in the institute. This gives the student flexibility to select courses according to his/her choice and also helps the student to set a carrier path. She also explained how the research culture at RIT has developed over the years and now RIT has a number of patents which have been filed has increased over the past few years.

She also added that how the gender ratio of students applying to take admission in RIT has changed over the years. She shared that at present about 35-40 % of the students in RIT are girl students. She discussed about Alumni Gratitude Fund and how the funds collected will be used at various levels. At the end of her address, Dr. Mrs. Sushma Kulkarni appealed to the alumni to help the institute in any way possible to further raise the brand image of RIT in the society. She also thanked various alumni who have donated to the college till date.

Now the forum was kept open for alumni members to share their views. The first alumnus to speak was Dr. Sanjay Vashishta, CEO First-Green Consulting Pvt. Ltd., Gurgaon, New Delhi, a consultancy firm in solar power. He assured his help to setup alumni chapter in New Delhi and also for if required for sanctions of government sponsored projects if required.

Next alumnus to speak was Mr. Rajesh Shrivastav, Asst. Vice President, and Reliance Industries Indore. He shared that he adopted the changes very fastly & become excelled in his life . He showed his concern towards environment by sharing that its is important to convert heavy vehicles to light to save fuel or convert to electric vehicles.

After this, Sharad Kumar Mishra spoke about his journey. He shared that he learnt a lot of life long learning skills such as leadership & other skills from RIT.
