
Governments have designed many new laws for women's safety. The hosts have informed many laws to the Katta members. Many safety applications were also

The library katta started with a brief explanation on NRC & CAA by the host. The Host informed participants with all the laws, their terminologies and their implications. Many stated this proposal may eventually be a grand success. There are several points in favour of the same as explained through the following bullet points.

Following points were discussed by the students in the favour.

- 1. No country can work without a register of its citizens, so the NRC seeks to maintain a list of its own citizens, as this will help exclude illegal citizens. This has been a major cause of concern especially in the eastern and north- eastern parts of our country.
- 2. The CAA does not exclude legal Indian citizens of any religion, but instead seeks to grant a respectable haven to those who have escaped religious persecution in neighbouring countries.
- 3. Neither does the CAA exclude the possibility of granting Indian citizenship to those from the majority religion in these three countries, who meet all the conditions stipulated for conventional cases.
- 4. Due to the expected concerns of people residing in the North- Eastern region of India, the law has excluded those living within states with an Inner Line Permit, from the purview of the CAA. Several of the states in this region are sparsely populated, with a substantial tribal population. Thus, there was a fear that an influx of immigrants, irrespective of religion, would alter the culture and affect the voting patterns, leading to a compromise in the cultural traditions. This has been respected by excluding the areas where an Inner Line Permit is necessary.
- 5. The cut-off date has been fixed at the year 2014, so the law does not in any way 'encourage' future immigration.
- 6. Though initially denying its role in outward illegal migration, Bangladesh has now extended a helping hand by confirming that those proven to be Bangladeshi nationals, will be taken back.
- 7. The admittedly botched NRC process in Assam need not be considered as the standard, as that was based on the Assam Accord, while the rest of India's exercise will be built around a separate draft, yet awaited. All the pros were considered and discussed briefly. Almost all participants agreed that, with the current situation in the north western India this law by the government is in the right direction with few conditions. While there are inherent pros to this proposal, there of course, also exist several cons. These are discussed below:
- 1. This law is highly discriminatory against one religion, going completely against the principles set in the Indian Constitution, especially Article 14 that recognizes equality amongst all religions.

- 2. There are severe implications also for the north- eastern region, as those states are sparsely populated, with a substantial tribal population, so influx of immigrants, irrespective of religion, could alter the demographics.
- 3. The NRC process that was carried out in Assam was highly flawed. The cut-off date there was fixed at March, 1971 due to the stipulations under the historical Assam Accord. Millions of poor people, especially the poor had to bet their lifetime savings, in procuring the requisite documentations. Yet, many were left out of the process.
- 4. Some detention centres have already built, and more are likely to be built to house the millions set to be displaced. This problem has been compounded by the fact that Bangladesh has on the whole, denied its role in any outward illegal migration, so could be reluctant to 'take back' its people.
- 5. The entire theory of massive illegal migration fails on the one count, that the Bangladesh economy is at present doing much better than its Indian counterpart. The last quarter saw the growth pegged at 8.1% as opposed to the 4.5% achieved by its larger neighbouring fact, Bangladesh's Per Capita Income at present is only marginally less than the state of West Bengal, or the Indian average, while in fact being higher than the state of Assam.



6. The entire process also risks compromising India's position on the global map. Bangladesh is in fact a friendly neighbour, and a key business ally in several ways, though inching closer to China at several policies. Besides the high economic growth the country presently enjoys, Bangladesh has for the most part not been a Theocratic state, so its vilification across the border, could have severe repercussions.

7.Even if theoretically the laws end up not being discriminatory, there is a major chance of domestic peace getting out of hands, thanks to the present profusion of instant messaging and social media. The street protests across the country at a time of economic strife, does not bode well for the bigger picture. The main lesson we draw from the discussion is that both viewpoints are perfectly fine, as long as the backing evidence is provided. Based on all the points and facts discussed, the attended on the note of not being too judgemental or biased towards any single side but to develop an overall thinking ability to analyse any given topic.



LIBRARY KATTA: THE WORLD BEYOND ENGINEERING

Consider the daily routine of an engineering student. He attends college. He works on

his engineering projects and his classwork and laboratory. He maintains his knowledge base with all the new technologies in the world. But he is certainly unaware of many socio-economic problems, current issues and recent events which affect the society as a whole.

On the contrary, Katta is a symbol of Discussions & Debates. The Katta is generally a centre place of any village. It is like a raised platform around a tree where people come usually in free time. And this is exactly what Library Katta is for our students. Students meet-up at the central library stairs each month on Wednesday to share their thoughts on a certain topic.

The Rajarambapu Institute of Technology has started this activity with the vision of overall development of students, which is also the ultimate purpose of education. Library Katta provides the platform to the students to share their thoughts on a particular issue. It is an informal gathering of the students to think and express themselves on social issues in the community by improving their reading of newspapers, books, magazines etc. There is no evaluation and assessment of any student. It is only informal discussion amongst them that improves their presentation skills and confidence level. As an engineer, the sensitivity to social and community issues is important so that the students can identify such problems and develop solutions.

In today's social life, a student's thinking ability seems to be diminishing. Creating a desire for students to observe themselves, to discover themselves, to think, to explain, and to present them in a way that they understand, in an attempt to achieve holistic development of the students.

Through this activity, we try to brainstorm thoughts on the issues that arise in society,

the objectives of the government, policies, social, cultural, economic, educational, national - international issues. The initiative aims to create positive change in the student, strengthen his academic level, take serious

thought and poise and develop a strong youth.

This initiative is very important for the library also, as it provides an opportunity for dialogue and discussion of the staff and students of the library along with the reader's needs. Assessment of the students' perceptions of their social concerns is necessitated. This is an attempt by the Library Katta to try to raise awareness. As an outcome of implementation, we are able to create social awareness of Library Katta as well as motivate students from this initiative. Our mission is to continue with the declaration, "You come and bring others" to benefit the society.

Sill today the total number of topics discussed is 17 and the number of students participated in the activity is approximately 600. Some of the topics discussed are Triple Talaq and the present day conditions of women in the society, CAA and its impact, Las Vegas- Another Indicators of Peacelessness, Clean India Movement- Just a slogan or Do we really care, Women's Safety etc.

The Outcome of the activity is observed as an increase in frequency of visits to the library by the users.

User satisfaction levels have increased. The informal feedback from the users in the form of dialogue also helped to correct or modify certain procedures that helped them. User interaction is encouraged by all the sections on an informal basis and this has improved the functioning and activities in the library.
